

CRHA OPEN SHOW POINT PROGRAM

The CRHA OPEN SHOW POINT PROGRAM is designed to award registered Rangerbreds by presenting LIFETIME POINTS in APPROVED categories and NATIONAL ROM's, COV's, SUPERIORS and SUPREME AWARDS. When the horse has earned the required number of LIFETIME POINTS to complete these awards. The horse can earn points towards the OPEN SHOW AWARDS by placing in OPEN 4-H, CRHA, BREEDS and Other organized shows. Points are not awarded for in-stable schooling shows. YOU WILL RECEIVE RESULT SHEETS THAT MUST BE COMPLETED AND SEND, ALONG WITH THE SHOWBILL WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE SHOW.

NATIONAL ROM'S

When a horse has earned **30 points** in Halter, or **30 Points** in Showmanship, or **20 points** in each separate performance, timed event, pleasure or equitation class. JUNIOR POINTS WILL COUNT TOWARD SENIOR ROM'S, ETC IN THE SAME CATEGORY.

SUPERIOR AWARDS

When a horse has earned **100 LIFETIME POINTS** IN HALTER OR SHOWMANSHIP, OR **50 LIFETIME POINTS** IN OTHER CATEGORIES. A horse can earn only one ROM in each category (Jr. & Sr.), classes to be considered ONE CATEGORY of the purpose of these awards. However, a horse can earn as many ROM'S and SUPERIOR'S in different categories as the horse qualifies for.

CERTIFICATES IN VERSATILITY

Will be earned when a horse has earned a minimum of **5 ROM's.** A horse will receive the SUPERIOR OPEN AWARD WHEN HE/SHE COMPLETES THE REQUIREMENTS OF **7 ROM'S** WITH AT LEAST ONE BEING HALTER-SHOWMANSHIP (YOUTH INCLUDED).

Note: A HORSE MUST EARN POINTS UNDER AT LEAST 3 JUDGES toward each ROM and under at least 5 JUDGES for a SUPERIOR. Horses competing at a DOUBLE POINT SHOW WITH TWO INDEPENDENT JUDGES WILL RECEIVE POINTS UNDER BOTH JUDGES.

Points shall be earned according to the NUMBER OF HORSES JUDGED IN THE CLASS. If any entry is scratched from a class, it will not be counted when points are tallied. If a horse is disqualified after entering the ring, it will be included in the tally.

HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE CRHA-ALL TRANSFERS MUST VE UP TO DATE WITH CRHA. OWNER AND HANDLER/RIDER MUST BE A CURRENT MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE CRHA. POINT ENROLLMENT IS \$5.00 PER HORSE AND MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO COMPETITION.

APPROVED CATEGORIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: All Colt, Stallion, halter (including Get of Sire). All Filly & Mare halter (including Produce of Dam and Broodmare). All Gelding halter, Youth and Adult Showmanship, All JR & Sr. division classes, and Open in Western Pleasure, Saddle Seat Pleasure, Hunt Seat and All Equitation. Costume, Pleasure Driving, Trail, Command, Western Riding, Hunter & Road Hack, Reining, Jumping, and all aspects of Gymkhana, three day eventing, Dressage and Side Saddle. Categories may be combined at the Chairpersons discretion, CATEGORIES NOT LISTED MAY BE INCLUDED IN CATEGORY SHOWN.

For clarification contact the Chairperson/Points keeper. Youth awards are earned in all Youth only classes or shows. YOUTH RIDERS EARN OPEN POINTS IN OPEN CLASSES. YOUTH POINTS ARE KEPT SEPARATELY FROM OPEN HORSE CLASSES AND SEPARATE YOUTH AWARDS ARE PRESENTED.

GRAND AND JR GRAND HALTER CHAMPIONS in any sex division shall receive 2 additional points. RESERVE AND JR RES GRAND shall receive 1 additional point.
